Why is proper disposal so important?

Properly dispose of wastes, and recycle when possible, to eliminate illegal discharges of pollutants into Ventura County's watersheds. Reuse and recycle hazardous and non-hazardous wastes when possible, to lower your disposal costs and the amount of waste entering our landfills and our watershed. Participate in materials exchange opportunities to reduce the waste you generate and to save money and resources.

You are responsible for implementing measures to prevent and enforce against illegal dumping of pollutants onto streets, gutters and into the storm drain system.

What Is Our Watershed?

Our watershed is the total land area from which stormwater drains into streams, rivers or other bodies of water. The storm drain system is a vast network of gutters, pipes and open channels designed for flood control, which directs untreated stormwater away from our communities. It is both illegal and harmful to allow solid or liquid wastes, including organic materials of any kind, into the storm drain system.
